Alligators in Drainage Pond ; The Sheriff is taking care of this. The alligators will eventually be caught and relocated. Please exercise caution in the meantime.

While the drainage pond is not our property, it is visited by many residents, who walk their dogs etc along its edge. There was a report of crawfish shells being dumped at ponds edge and this may be attracting the alligator. If you observe anyone dumping in this area, please notify the sheriff. The Association is petitioning the Public Works to install a “No Dumping” sign.

Also a reminder not to tip toxic liquids such as paint down the drains.
